STAKES OFFERED:

Any hound that does not have a prior qualifying score must first obtain a Qualified Courser title.

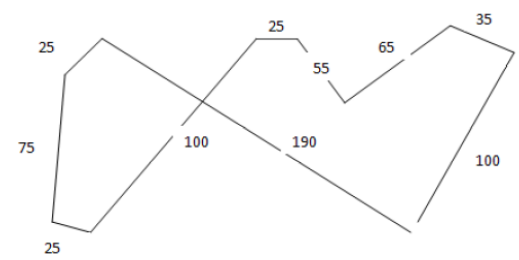
OPEN: Open to all Basenjies that have attained at least one of the following: AKC Junior Courser with prior qualifying score, AKC Qualified Courser, ASFA Field Champion title, or CKC Field Champion title. Basenjies that are disqualified from AKC, ASFA, or CKC field trials may not be entered. **OPEN VETERANS:** Open to all Basenjies which are eligible to enter open or special stake and meet the age requirement for veteran, as established by their breed club. **SPECIALS:** Open to all Basenjies that have earned their AKC Field Champion title. **SINGLE STAKE** will be offered. **BEST IN FIELD WILL NOT BE OFFERED.**

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Entry fees of hounds deemed lame or in season at roll call will be refunded. Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period. Spayed and neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, may be entered. Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available. The Field Committee reserves the right to remove aggressive dogs from the trial site. BCONC reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the test. **A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose hound not competing in the course in progress. PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG! Violators will be subject to a bench hearing and/or fine.**

Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Spayed and neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications may be entered. Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of plastic bag strips. Backup equipment will be available. The members of the Basenji Club of Northern California reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the test/trial.

A penalty of \$10.00 may be assessed for each loose hound not currently running a course during event hours. A fine of \$10.00 per occurrence may be assessed for failure to clean up after your dogs while on grounds.
